

CHICAGO COMICFEST DEALER CONTRACT MARCH 12 - 13, 2005

1. TABLE SPACE & DISPLAY BOARDS
 - A. The Chicago ComicFest and Motor City Conventions Inc.(MCCI) will provide one 8'X 2'table, two chairs and a reasonable amount of space behind the table, with each table.
 - B. You are entitled to the same amount of display board space as you have tables (i.e. 3 tables=24 feet). Any problems should be brought to the attention of the convention coordinator.
 - C. MCCI provides as many tables as you pay for. Extra tables, for use as backups, may be available at the con for an additional charge.
 - D. Dealer will keep table areas clean and is responsible for any damage. Dealer agrees to leave their area "broom clean" at the close of the con.
 - E. MCCI reserves the right to change table locations at the promoters discretion.
 - F. Electricity is available from the Ramada O'Hare at the rate of \$50.00.
2. DISPLAY REGULATIONS
 - A. No exhibit may block or interfere with any neighboring exhibit.
 - B. Dealers must police their own areas to be sure that noise levels from sound systems is kept to a minimum and does not interfere with others. MCCI reserves the right to determine at what point sound constitutes interference with others and must be discontinued.
 - C. Character and compliance of exhibits is subject to the approval of MCCI and all decisions regarding the display of material shall rest solely with MCCI.
 - D. Any Damage caused to the building by a dealer is the sole responsibility of the dealer.
 - E. No smoking or alcohol is allowed in the exhibit hall at any time.
 - F. Dealer agrees to remain set up during all open hours of the Convention. No early breakdown is allowed without the prior consent of MCCI.
3. PAYMENT FOR SPACE and SUBLETTING
 - A. Dealer understands the payment policy and agrees to pay the fees as listed on the Dealer Table Request Form.
 - B. Refunds for table fees may be requested until February 14 , 2005. After that refunds will only be available if the show is sold out.
 - C. Refunds will not be available due to Force Majeure (see section 7).
 - D. Subletting is not allowed without the express written consent of Motor City Conventions.
 - E. Sharing of table space is not allowed without the express written permission of Motor City Conventions. In the case of more than one dealer sharing one table; the person whose name appears on this contract assumes full responsibility for that table, as specified here. **MCCI must be notified, at the time of table reservation, of dealers intending to share space.**
4. MERCHANDISE FOR SALE
 - A. Dealer agrees that all merchandise for sale is legal and licensed. Dealers selling unlicensed or "bootleg" merchandise, including t-shirts, photographs, video tapes etc., may be ejected from the convention with no refund of table fees.
 - B. Adult Material
 1. Dealer agrees not to sell or distribute any adult material to minors.
 2. All Adults Only material must be either behind the table or, if displayed on the table, bagged or covered so that minors may not open it. Any adult material depicting nudity must be "blinded" (i.e. the nudity or sexual conduct must be covered).
 3. Adult video tapes and magazines are not allowed to be openly displayed. They must be kept behind the tables. A sign may be posted to let customers know that you carry that merchandise.

5. SECURITY
 - A. MCCI agrees to provide overnight security, from 9:30pm Friday-8:00am Saturday and 6:00pm Saturday-9:30am Sunday.

- B. The Chicago ComicFest, Motor City Conventions Inc., and the Ramada Plaza Hotel O'Hare are not responsible for any theft or loss.(See section 7).
- C. Dealer is responsible for their own security during show hours.

6. LIABILITY and FORCE MAJEURE

- A. The Dealer agrees to protect, keep, and save Motor City Conventions Inc., the promoter of the event, forever harmless from any damage(s) or charge(s) imposed for violations of any ordinance or regulation by the Dealer, his employees or agents, as well as failure to comply with the terms and agreements of this contract. Further, Dealers shall at all times protect, indemnify, save, and keep harmless Motor City Conventions Inc. against and from any loss, cost, damage, liability, or expense which arises out of or from or by reason of any act or omission of the Dealer, his employees, or agents.
 - B. In the event that the Ramada Plaza Hotel O'Hare or any part of the exhibit area thereof is unavailable, whether for the entire event or a portion of the event, as a result of fire, flood, tempest, or another such cause, or as a result of governmental intervention, malicious damage, acts of war, strike, labor disputes, riot, or agency which MCCI has no control, or should MCCI decide that because of any such cause it is necessary to cancel, postpone, or re-site the show, or reduce installation time, exhibit time, or move out time, MCCI shall not be liable to indemnify or reimburse the Dealer in respect of any damage or loss, direct or indirect, arising as a result thereof.
7. AMENDMENTS: MCCI shall have the full power in the interpretation and enforcement of all contract regulations contained herein, and the power to make such amendments thereto, and such further rules and regulations as shall be considered necessary and proper.
8. The foregoing represents the agreement between the undersigned dealer and Motor City Conventions Inc., the promoters of the Chicago ComicFest, for the convention on March 12 - 13, 2005.
